America's leading Job Corps operator wins New York contract **US Department of Labor selects MTC to manage Delaware Valley Job Corps Center**

(CENTERVILLE, Utah) – Management & Training Corporation (MTC) has been awarded a contract to operate the Delaware Valley Job Corps Center in Callicoon, New York, starting April 1, 2007. The contract award was announced by the US Department of Labor's regional Job Corps office, in Boston.

“We are very pleased to earn this contract,” said MTC Training Programs Sr. Vice President John Pedersen. “MTC is also involved in the operation of the Oneonta Job Corps Center which is within 50 miles of Delaware Valley. This new contract should provide us the opportunity to have the two New York centers work together, to the benefit of students, staff and the respective communities.”

The initial contract period for the Delaware Valley Job Corps Center is April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009. The value of the contract over the first two year period is \$19,981,525. Additionally, there are three, one-year options the National Job Corps office can exercise.

The Delaware Valley center is located near the New York-Pennsylvania border, approximately 90 miles northwest of New York City. The majority of its 396 residential students are from the New York City area.

Delaware Valley Job Corps Center students will have the opportunity to earn their high school diplomas or to receive GED training and testing. They will also have the opportunity to receive training in a variety of fields, including: automotive repair, business technology, carpentry, culinary arts and security.

“In addition to educating and training the students, MTC is also obligated through this contract to place the Job Corps graduates into jobs, higher education or the military,” added MTC Job Corps Regional Vice President JoAnn McDougal. “It is our goal to make sure every one of our graduates knows exactly where they are going next, and what they will be doing, before leaving the center.”

With the addition of Delaware Valley, Management & Training Corporation will now operate – or partner in the operation of – 26 Job Corps centers across the United States. MTC is the nation's leading Job Corps center operator.

MTC also operates 12 private correctional facilities through its corrections division, in Arizona, New Mexico, Ohio, Texas and Australia.
