



# MTC & CNCC offer one final Helping hand to the community

As management prepares to change, surplus equipment is donated to local charities & families

**(PENETANGUISHENE, Ontario)** – After operating the Central North Correctional Centre (CNCC) for the past five years, Management and Training Corporation (MTC) will transfer operation of the facility to the Ontario Public Service on November 8, 2006. Preparations for the management transfer have included a large equipment donation by MTC and CNCC to charities and families in the greater Penetanguishene area.

Each elementary school in Penetanguishene and Midland has been asked to identify five families who could use a computer system in their homes. The computer systems were purchased by MTC for use at CNCC. Now, rather than transporting the equipment to other MTC facilities – or selling it – the company has chosen to provide it to the local community.

“MTC corporate officials immediately embraced the idea of donating the computers and other equipment,” said CNCC spokesperson Peter Mount. “Be it cash donations...community building projects...food bank turkey donations...or this final gesture, Management & Training Corporation has been a strong community supporter since day one.”

In addition to the computer equipment, MTC is also donating its inmate transport vehicle fleet to local charities. The Midland OSPCA, Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre and the local YMCA will each receive a 2002 cargo van – fully outfitted for their needs – free of charge.

“I’ve spent a lot of time in this wonderful area and have made many friends, both at the facility and in the community,” said MTC Corrections Director John Shanks. “I believe these donations are one last, fitting way to say thank you. The Southern Georgian Bay region is a beautiful part of the world and MTC has been proud to be part of it.”

Other donations will include corporate printers and photocopy equipment to a variety of organizations in need across the region.
