America's leading Job Corps operator wins Kentucky contract **Department of Labor selects MTC to manage Earle C. Clements Job Corps Academy**

(CENTERVILLE, Utah) – Management & Training Corporation (MTC) has been awarded a contract to operate the Earle C. Clements Job Corps Academy in Morganfield, Kentucky, starting June 1, 2008. The contract award was announced by the US Department of Labor's regional Job Corps office in Philadelphia. Clements is the second largest of the 122 centers in the Job Corps system, with 1300 students.

“We are very proud to win such a large contract,” said MTC Chairman of the Board and Founder Dr. Robert Marquardt. “MTC is a high performance Job Corps contractor. Winning this contract is a reflection of the quality work our employees do across the country. We look forward to providing Earle C. Clements students with many opportunities to improve and maximize their potential.”

The initial contract period for the Earle C. Clements Job Corps Academy is June 1, 2008 through May 31, 2010. The value of the contract over the first two year period is \$59,840,932. Additionally, there are three, one-year options the National Job Corps office can exercise.

The Clements center is located in rural northwestern Kentucky, about 50 miles west of Owensboro, Kentucky, near the Illinois and Indiana state lines. The 1300 residential students are primarily from Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky and Ohio.

Earle C. Clements Job Corps Academy students will have the opportunity to earn their high school diplomas or to receive GED training and testing. They will also receive training in schools of construction, automotive repair & transportation, and health sciences.

“It will be an honor to educate and train students from such a large portion of the eastern United States,” added MTC Training Programs Sr. Vice President John Pedersen. “We anticipate employing 500 people at the center. Most of the employees are expected to be hired from the staff currently in place there.”

With the addition of Earle C. Clements, Management & Training Corporation will now operate – or partner in the operation of – 26 Job Corps centers across the United States. MTC is the nation's leading Job Corps center operator.

Through its Corrections Division MTC also operates 12 private correctional facilities in Arizona, California, New Mexico, Ohio and Texas. The company also educates and trains the changing world through its International Workforce Development Division.
