MTC earns bid to construct and operate Idaho facility

400-bed substance abuse treatment, minimum security correctional facility to open in 2010

(CENTERVILLE, Utah) – Management & Training Corporation (MTC) is pleased to have been awarded a bid from the Idaho Department of Corrections to construct and operate a new 400-bed, minimum security correctional facility south of Boise. The Correctional Alternative Placement Program (CAPP) facility will provide intensive substance abuse treatment opportunities for Idaho inmates, starting in 2010.

“MTC is very pleased to earn this contract,” said the company’s Corrections Sr. Vice President, Odie Washington. “MTC has more than 25 years experience in turning around troubled lives by providing educational opportunities and treatment programs. We look forward to demonstrating our expertise by assisting those in need at this new facility in our neighboring state of Idaho.”

MTC will first coordinate the design and construction of the facility, and then operate it in Ada County, Idaho. The five-year base contract with a five-year option has a total value of approximately \$10 million annually. MTC will employ up to 90 staff to oversee the CAPP facility.

The correctional facility will provide comprehensive residential substance abuse and cognitive behavioral programming to three offender populations: reentry offenders, offenders under court jurisdiction and offenders under the jurisdiction of the Commission for Pardons and Parole.

Ground will be broken on the new facility soon. Construction is expected to take about 23 months. Ormond Builders of Idaho Falls is the general contractor while LCA Architects of Boise will complete the design work. Like MTC, each of these Idaho companies has been providing quality products and service for more than a quarter century.
