MTC health care joint venture earns new contract

First Medical Management to provide medical care for 1250 Virginia inmates

(CENTERVILLE, Utah) – First Medical Management (FMM) has been awarded a contract to provide medical, dental, optical and mental health treatment to inmates at Virginia’s Hampton Roads Regional Jail. The three-year, \$24-million contract will run from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. FMM is a corrections medical care joint venture, created in 2005 by Management & Training Corporation and First Correctional Medical (FCM) of Tucson, Arizona.

“We are very excited to be selected to take over this contract,” said FMM Medical Operations Senior Director Richard Dull. “This is the third major contract for First Medical Management. We are pleased to see the FMM name becoming more and more recognized within our industry during the relatively short time this joint venture has been operating. We look forward to providing quality medical care for the inmates at Hampton Roads Regional Jail.”

The Hampton Roads correctional facility serves the Virginia communities of Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk and Portsmouth. The relatively-new facility opened in March 1998 on a 38-acre site. It serves both male and female offenders.

First Medical Management plans to employ 41 doctors, dentists and other health care professionals at the regional jail. Additionally, two new jobs will be created at the MTC corporate office in Centerville, Utah to service the contract.

FMM has similar health and medical care contracts in Maryland and Tennessee. This contract is between First Medical Management and the Hampton Roads Regional Jail Authority.
