MTC elects new Board of Directors member

Utah's fourth largest private employer selects former CEO of US Government's foreign aid agency

(CENTERVILLE, Utah) – Management & Training Corporation (MTC) today elected Andrew S. Natsios to its eight-member Board of Directors.

Most recently in a long and distinguished career, Natsios served as the chief executive officer for the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). This government agency employs 8100 employees in 80 countries, with an annual budget of nearly \$14 billion. USAID programs include infrastructure, economic growth and political reform, international health, agriculture and a host of other humanitarian relief efforts.

“We are very pleased to have Andrew join our Board of Directors,” said MTC President Scott Marquardt. “In addition to the management and operation of Federal Job Corps Centers and private correctional facilities around the world, MTC is also expanding its focus to other education and employment training opportunities across the globe. Andrew Natsios served as USAID CEO from May 2001 through January of this year. During that time, the program was so successful its budget was nearly doubled – from \$7.9 billion in FY 2001 to nearly \$14 billion in the current fiscal year. During his tenure, USAID coordinated massive reconstruction projects in Afghanistan, Indonesia, Iraq, Sudan and elsewhere.

“I am pleased and honored to be elected to the MTC Board of Directors,” Natsios said. “This corporation is rapidly developing a strong reputation within the international aid community. I am excited to see what lies ahead for MTC as it carries its education and job training expertise beyond Job Corps and corrections, into the many countries that desperately need these skills.”

Earlier in his career, Natsios served in a number of state government posts in his home state of Massachusetts. From 1975 to 87, Natsios served in the State House of Representatives. During that tenure he was voted Legislator of the Year by: the Massachusetts Municipal Association, Citizens for Limited Taxation and the Massachusetts School Committees Association.

Natsios is married and has three children. He now resides in Silver Springs, Maryland.
