## U.S. Department of Labor Selects Management and Training Corporation to Operate Georgia Job Corps Center

October 1, 2003 – **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

(CENTERVILLE, Utah) – Management and Training Corporation (MTC), the nation’s leading operator of federal Job Corps education and training centers, has been awarded a new management contract this week. Following a competitive bid process, the United States Department of Labor has selected MTC to operate its Brunswick Job Corps Center in southeast Georgia. The 2-year contract value is \$16.9-million for operations and career transition services.

“We are very pleased to earn this contract,” said MTC Government and Community Relations Vice President Curtis Price. “Management and Training Corporation has dedicated more than twenty years to developing a proven formula for assisting at-risk youth. We are excited to apply our successful formula to help young people in Georgia achieve their personal and professional goals. MTC also looks forward to developing strong connections with Brunswick businesses and civic organizations.”

Brunswick Job Corps Center is located midway between Savannah, Georgia and Jacksonville, Florida along the Georgia coast. It is eight miles north of Brunswick, Georgia. The 39-acre site is the former home of the Glynco Naval Air Station. The center was established in 1979.

Atlanta-based American Business Corporation (ABC) will be a major subcontractor at the center, providing career transition service and vocational education programming. ABC President Jackie Back says, “This is an exciting opportunity for ABC and MTC to join forces and apply our combined expertise to benefit both the Brunswick students and the local community.”

Approximately 400 Job Corps students, ages 16 to 24, attend the Brunswick center. Nearly all of the male and female students reside on center where they receive general education and job skill training in fields such as: automotive repair, carpentry, health occupations, office skills, painting and plumbing. The federal Job Corps program also assists students with job placement and provides follow-up support for at least one full year after they complete their training.

Management and Training Corporation was founded as a Job Corps management provider in 1981. MTC operates 23 centers, more than any other Job Corps management contractor. Earlier this year the National Job Corps Association named Management and Training Corporation its *Member of the Year*.

MTC will officially assume management of the Brunswick Job Corps Center on January 1, 2004 following a one-month transition period. The contract is renewable by the DOL for up to five years.
