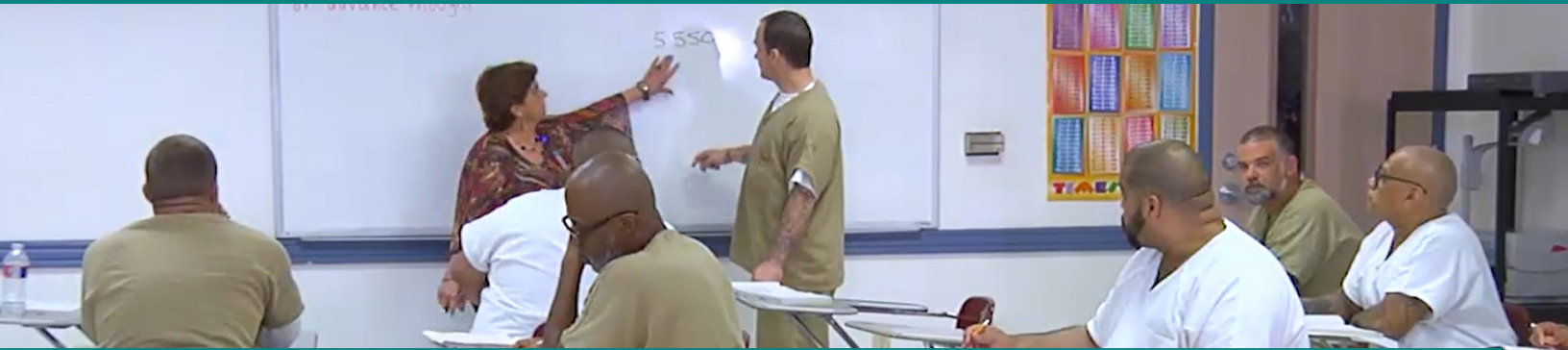

Certifications and Education Programs

Residents at the Lindsey State Jail can earn industry-recognized certifications through a partnership with the National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER). NCCER certifications in painting and facility maintenance construction courses providing residents with the edge to get jobs after they're released. Employment after release from prison is key to reducing recidivism.

Lindsey State Jail is accredited by the American Correctional Association—achieving over 99% compliance for both mandatory and non-mandatory standards in its most recent audit. The facility is also certified by the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA).
