It's MTC's responsibility to ensure these individuals have access to necessary services while they're in the facility including healthcare, court and legal resources, visitation, recreation, and educational programs when possible.

The Bluebonnet Detention Center strives to be a good neighbor and promises to benefit the local economy. The facility has created over 200 new jobs mostly for Jones County residents. Jobs have an average wage of \$20.49, an impressive wage in a county where the median home price is \$68,300.
