Job Corps Prepares Young People for Success

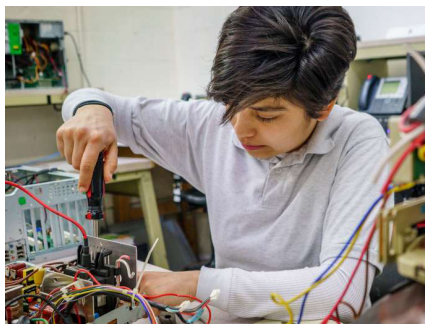
